

## NLUJ LAW REVIEW SUBMISSION GUIDELINES (BLOG)

The NLUJ Law Review Blog, the official blog of National Law University, Jodhpur's flagship journal, welcomes original, unpublished submissions on contemporary legal issues across all areas of law. Contributions from academics, legal professionals, practitioners, research scholars, and students are invited, including articles, research pieces, opinions, case comments, and short notes. The Blog fosters timely interdisciplinary analysis and commentary on national and international legal developments.

### Eligibility

Co-authorship is permitted up to two authors. Submissions are accepted on a rolling basis. Authors must submit via the designated Google Form accessible on the official website ([www.nlujlawreview.in](http://www.nlujlawreview.in)) or directly through the provided [link](#). Manuscripts must be exclusive and not under consideration elsewhere during the review process. Plagiarism in any form results in immediate disqualification.

### Manuscript Specifications

- **Word limit:** 1,500 words (exclusive of endnotes); longer submissions may be published in parts at the Editorial Board's discretion.
- **Anonymity:** Authors must ensure to exclude author names, affiliations, or identifying details from the manuscript and filename to facilitate double-blind review; the name of the file should be limited to the article name only. For example, 'Title of the Article\_NLUJLR.'
- **Summary:** Authors are requested to provide a short summary of the article along with 3-4 keywords.

### Formatting Requirements

- **Title:** Garamond, 14 pt, all caps, bold.
- **Body text:** Garamond, 12 pt, 1.5-line spacing, single line space between paragraphs.
- **File format:** .doc or .docx.
- **Citations:** Embed hyperlinks in the body for all supporting materials and legal texts; use endnotes only where hyperlinks are unavailable (no speaking footnotes or endnotes permitted).

### Review Policy

All submissions undergo a rigorous double-blind peer review process, typically concluding within 30 days. The Editorial Board reserves absolute discretion over acceptance or rejection and does not provide advance decisions based on abstracts or outlines. Initial acceptance may require substantive or stylistic revisions; final publication is contingent on satisfactory incorporation of editorial feedback. Minor edits may follow submission of the revised manuscript. Upon publication, copyright vests in the Blog. Posts initially published on the blog website may be

cross-published on other platforms by the Editorial Board, with due acknowledgement to the authors.
