The NLUJ Law Review Blog, the official blog of National Law University, Jodhpur's flagship journal, welcomes original, unpublished submissions on contemporary legal issues across all areas of law. Contributions from academics, legal professionals, practitioners, research scholars, and students are invited, including articles, research pieces, opinions, case comments, and short notes. The Blog fosters timely interdisciplinary analysis and commentary on national and international legal developments.

The Board of Editors at NLUJ Law Review are pleased to announce the call for submissions for the NLUJ Law Review Blog ("Blog"). The Blog invites all kinds of original and unpublished submissions, including (but not limited to) articles, research pieces, opinions, case comments and short notes on any contemporary subject matter related to all the areas of law from all academicians, authors, legal professionals and students.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Eligibility

Co-authorship is permitted up to two authors. Submissions are accepted on a rolling basis. Authors must submit via the designated Google Form accessible on the official website (www.nlujlawreview.in) or directly through the provided link. Manuscripts must be exclusive and not under consideration elsewhere during the review process. Plagiarism in any form results in immediate disqualification.

Manuscript Specifications

The manuscript should not exceed 1,500 words, excluding endnotes. Submissions that exceed this limit may, at the discretion of the Editorial Board, be considered for publication in multiple parts. To ensure a fair double-blind review process, authors must maintain strict anonymity by removing their names, institutional affiliations, and any other identifying information from both the manuscript and the file name. The file name should contain only the title of the article, followed by the journal identifier. For instance, it should be formatted as: Title of the Article_NLUJLR. Additionally, authors are required to include a brief summary of the article along with three to four relevant keywords, which will help readers quickly understand the scope and focus of the submission.

Formatting Requirements

The title of the manuscript should be in Garamond, 14-point font, bold, and written in all capital letters. The body text must be formatted in Garamond, 12-point font with 1.5-line spacing, with a single line space between paragraphs. The manuscript must be submitted in .doc or .docx file format. For citations, authors should embed hyperlinks in the body text for all supporting materials and legal sources, and endnotes should be used only where hyperlinks are unavailable, with no speaking footnotes or endnotes permitted.

Review Policy

All submissions undergo a rigorous double-blind peer review process, typically concluding within 30 days. The Editorial Board reserves absolute discretion over acceptance or rejection and does not provide advance decisions based on abstracts or outlines. Initial acceptance may require substantive or stylistic revisions; final publication is contingent on satisfactory incorporation of editorial feedback. Minor edits may follow submission of the revised manuscript. Upon publication, copyright vests in the Blog. Posts initially published on the blog website may be cross-published on other platforms by the Editorial Board, with due acknowledgement to the authors.
